# The God Who Is: The Meaning Of Life

**WARM UP:** Where do you draw meaning for living? Why from there?

**READ**: John 1:1-18, Matthew 5:2-12, Luke 4:17-19 (scriptures on pg 3)

**FOCUS**: We will come to know the meaning of life when we discover the God who is.

# **OBSERVE (10 minutes)**

# **Who God Is (John 1:1-18)**

- This mirrors the Genesis account of creation "In the beginning....". It is
  declarative of origins, that <u>God is the creator</u> of all things through
  Jesus Christ and the physical laws of nature which he established.
- God is uncreated and all things begin with him. This is what it means that God is eternal.
- As shared in the Encyclopedia Britannica, Greek culture to whom the Gospel of John was written understood the terminology used for "Word" as that which was used for "the divine reason implicit in the cosmos, ordering it and giving it form and meaning". "The Word" implied the plan for and meaning of life.
- This eternal Word became flesh in Jesus Christ. Thus <u>Jesus is God</u> and shows us the meaning of life.
- God came to have relationship with his creation through the incarnate Christ.

# How He Said to Live

- Your identity in Christ is the only thing that will last for eternity.
  - The revelation of who God has called us to <u>be</u> needs to shape our identity as of first reference. It is where we will find true fulfillment and the meaning of life. (Eph 2:10)
- It is through Jesus' teachings that we learn more about the character and nature of God.
- When you become a Christian, God calls you a citizen of the Kingdom of Heaven.
- Being Christian does not mean that I no longer have an ethnicity, but it does mean my Christianity defines my allegiances, my response to offense and my activity in this world. And that response is dealt with at the cross.
- It is an idolatry of identity if you put anything before the God you
  worship and the manner in which he chooses to both define and
  liberate you. This is true whether it be nationality, ethnicity, sexuality,
  class or political affiliation.

# What He Came to Do

- God came to restore the meaning of life by destroying the power of sin and death in fallen humanity.
  - Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, for the devil has been sinning from the beginning.
     The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil. - 1 John 3:8
- Jesus came to bring God's forgiveness, healing, freedom, and favor to humanity.
  - And the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." Lk 4:17-19
- Jesus can help you in your anxieties, comfort you in your fears and free you from your resentments. He has stood in your place at the cross to shoulder your guilt. By his resurrection from the dead Jesus provides hope as you press through life's discouragements. God does so because he made you and understands you.

# Week of July 5th 2020

# **REFLECT AND DISCUSS (30 min)**

- Since God created all things and is himself uncreated, discuss what impact this has on creation. What is creation's responsibilities and comforts by knowing this?
- When we remove the crutches of physical accountability, we see where our passions truly lie. What am I giving myself to when no one else is around? What do I choose to invest in and pursue?
- Jesus claimed and proved himself to be God. Have you acknowledged this in your heart? Have you received forgiveness of your sins and His gift of eternal life?

# **PRAY & TAKE ACTION**

- Acknowledge the God of the Bible as the ONE true God, uncreated and eternal, who came in the flesh as Jesus Christ.
- Pray and thank him for his mercy and goodness revealed in Jesus Christ's life, sacrificial atoning death, and resurrection.
- Ask him to forgive you and heal you from finding your identity in created things and ideologies rather than Christ.
- Thank him for making you a 'new creation in Christ Jesus' free from slavery to sin. Pray for your friends and family to find identity and purpose in Christ.
